

Celebration of “State Child Protection Day”

Considering the Child as a top priority of developmental agenda; NEDAN visualized that providing opportunity to the children is similar effort as farmer working in the field. NEDAN always believe that children are the Nations’ backbone to strengthen all the dimension of development process. Today government doesn’t have enough wings to make accountable all children who are at hardship also living into the backward areas where their basic rights are not being found such as right to development, right to protected, right to play, right to survival, right to health, right to freedom of opinion and right to participation. All these incapacitated of administration children are remained as vulnerable and in any time they are seems to be face all sort hardships. To strengthen the networks among children and adolescent NEDAN has organized the “State Child Protection Day” supported by UNICEF on 4th March 2018 at Baganpara CCPI (Community Child Protection Institute) Kochugaon in Kokrajhar district. The invited guest in the program was the Honorable respected village headman (Gaonbura), CPC (Child Protection Committee), SMC (School Management Committee) and Children and Adolescents from different locations.



The State Child Protection day program was participated by the children of different locations from Lung sung, New Bashbari, Bashbari and Duramari under Titaguri, block, Nowerbhita, Muncherghop under Dotma block and Baganpara, Shikarpur, Kochugaon Relief camp, Bharatnagar and new Raikhungbari under Kochugaon block.

There are 150 plus children were gathered in the Child Protection day from three blocks of Kokrajhar district. Mr. DigambarNarzary the Chairperson of NEDAN foundation highlighted the objectives of the Child Protection day. He briefly expressed the meaning of Child Protection day and why it is observed in Assam in every year. The most important related issues for observing the Child Protection day is to prevent the child trafficking, child marriage and child labor in the world he said.

The village headman of Baganpara, Mr. Chineswar Narzary also highlighted the issues of child labour, child trafficking and child marriage during the conducting State Child Protection day in Kochugaon block. He also added the decreasing of child marriage rate, child trafficking after the intervention of NEDAN in Baganpara village under Kochugaon block. Mr. Chineswar Narzary also condemned the working of child labour from the village in other states of India.

After addressing the main objectives of the program, different activities was conducted related to State Child Protection day. The different activities like volley ball for boys and kabbadi match for girls and along with that cultural program was also conducted to prevent the child marriage and child trafficking in different places. Children took active participation and showed their eagerness in activities during the celebration.
